

PATIENT ORGANISATION FUNDING AND SUPPORT

Valneva is committed to transparency of financial relationships with patient organisations. Patient organisations (also referred to as Patient Advisory Groups (PAGs), Healthcare Charities or Patient Groups) aim to improve the lives of people with a particular disease or medical condition. As well as supporting their activities.

Working with patient organisations can help us have a better appreciation of the specific needs of patients, and how better to support these needs.

We are required to provide details of patient organisations to which we have provided financial support, together with a description of the nature of the support engaged, including a description of the services provided. In addition, we also disclose the payment of expenses relating to accommodation and travel (both in the UK and abroad) incurred by patient organisations in the course of their interaction with us.

In 2019, Valneva UK contracted the Chief Executive for the Encephalitis Society, a UK charity, to support awareness of this misunderstood condition. Valneva UK paid a gift in kind, to the companies Ardelis Health in the US (USD14750 equivalent to £11349) and to National Public Relations in Canada (CAD3000 equivalent to £1679) for PR/Media work on World Encephalitis Day 2019 in their respective countries - the Society itself did not receive this.

Valneva UK also acted as a sponsor for the Encephalitis Conference (sponsorship amount £1800), a scientific conference organized by the Encephalitis Society.

The Chief Executive of the Encephalitis Society received £420 as an honorarium for speaking on Valneva's behalf at the Annual Conference of the British Global and Travel Health Association (BGTHA) and was recompensed for travel expenses amounting to £180.74 in relation to this engagement. Additionally, Valneva UK paid for travel and accommodation of the Chief Executive to the US amounting to £6574.44 to facilitate a meeting with representatives from Valneva US to discuss the possibility of the usage of the Encephalitis Society's Japanese Encephalitis patient videos for medical education purposes in the US.

Furthermore, Valneva UK supported the Encephalitis Society with an educational grant amounting to £14000 in connection to the Rugby World Cup 2020 and paid license fees of £15000 for the use of the Encephalitis Society's Japanese Encephalitis patient videos for medical education purposes. A payment of an unrestricted educational grant for £30000 to the Encephalitis Society concludes all payments in 2019.
