PATIENT ORGANISATION FUNDING AND SUPPORT

Valneva is committed to transparency of financial relationships with patient organisations. Patient organisations (also referred to as Patient Advisory Groups (PAGs), Healthcare Charities or Patient Groups) aim to improve the lives of people with a particular disease or medical condition. As well as supporting their activities.

Working with patient organisations can help us have a better appreciation of the specific needs of patients, and how better to support these needs.

We are required to provide details of patient organisations to which we have provided financial support, together with a description of the nature of the support engaged, including a description of the services provided. In addition, we also disclose the payment of expenses relating to accommodation and travel (both in the UK and abroad) incurred by patient organisations during their interaction with us.

In 2022, Valneva UK supported the Encephalitis Society with an unrestricted grant for £30,000, to contribute to their efforts to support adults and children affected by Encephalitis, raise awareness about the condition and its subsequent problems among relevant professionals, and conduct research and work in partnership with other researchers and their establishments.

Valneva UK contracted the agency “Health + Commerce” in the US to provide strategic and tactical public relations support (“PR Support”) to the Encephalitis Society to build awareness for World Encephalitis Day (WED) on 22nd February 2022, in the U.S. and Canada. This benefit in kind was donated by Valneva to the Encephalitis Society and had an equivalent monetary value of £16,119 (USD20,000). A donation agreement between Valneva and the Encephalitis Society is in place and the Society itself did not receive this money.



Valneva UK also acted as a sponsor for the Encephalitis Conference (sponsorship amount £1,800 excl. VAT), a scientific conference organized by the Encephalitis Society, which concludes all payments in 2022.
