

PATIENT ORGANISATION FUNDING AND SUPPORT

Valneva is committed to transparency of financial relationships with patient organisations. Patient organisations (also referred to as Patient Advisory Groups (PAGs), Healthcare Charities or Patient Groups) aim to improve the lives of people with a particular disease or medical condition. As well as supporting their activities.

Working with patient organisations can help us have a better appreciation of the specific needs of patients, and how better to support these needs.

We are required to provide details of patient organisations to which we have provided financial support, together with a description of the nature of the support engaged, including a description of the services provided. In addition, we also disclose the payment of expenses relating to accommodation and travel (both in the UK and abroad) incurred by patient organisations in the course of their interaction with us.

In 2018 Valneva UK contracted the Chief Executive for the Encephalitis Society, a UK charity, to support awareness of this misunderstood condition. Valneva UK paid a gift in kind, (in USD equivalent to £7862.03), to Ardelis Health for PR/Media work on World Encephalitis Day 2018- the Society itself did not receive this. The chief Executive was paid £440 for a recording made in London on Japanese Encephalitis, and received a further £1775.34 honorarium and travel expenses for speaking on Valneva's behalf at the NECTM Congress in Sweden. Valneva UK paid licence fees of £15000 for the use of the Encephalitis Society's Japanese Encephalitis patient videos for medical-educational purposes. A payment of an unrestricted educational grant for £30000 to the Encephalitis Society concludes all payments in 2018.
